Pack up the family or make a date with some friends and see just how many winter adventures you can go on this season. Here are a few ideas to get you started.

Skating

The City of Cornwall offers up to a dozen outdoor rinks in neighbourhood and community parks. A short drive to Countryside Adventures in Moose Creek offers double the fun – with both skating and tubing!

Skiing

Big Ben Ski Centre is the perfect place to learn, or re-learn how to downhill ski and snowboard. You can enjoy the scenery on cross country skis at Guindon Park, Summerstown Trails and the Upper Canada Bird Sanctuary.

Fat Biking

Gray's Creek, Guindon Park, and the Summerstown Trails offer paths for the most challenging winter workout on wheels.

Hiking & Snowshoeing

Breathe the crisp air and enjoy the views across the kilometers of trails available at Lamoureux Park, Gray's Creek, Guindon Park, Summerstown Trails, Upper Canada Migratory Bird Sanctuary, and Glengarry Trails.

Ice Fishing

Relax and drop your line at the historic Hoople Creek and take part in the 2,000-year-old cold weather practice.

Bird-Watching


Slow down and watch the birds at Guindon Park, the Upper Canada Migratory Bird Sanctuary, Glengarry Trails, and the Summerstown Trails.

Tobogganing

Experience the thrill as you slide down hills in Lamoureux Park, off the McConnell overpass, and along the Long Sault Parkway.

Prefer to stay indoors?

The Benson Centre's pickleball and tennis courts are available for rent, and the Aquatic Centre offers public swimming daily.
